





POKE PRIORITY POINTS

Our Poke Priority Point system is allocated in a fair, equitable, and consistent manner. Our goal is to reward longtime supporters of Wyoming Athletics while allowing new donors and season ticket holders to acquire appropriate benefits. A donor's priority points are based off their lifetime giving to Wyoming Athletics. This includes gifts made to the Cowboy Joe Club, Steer-A-Year, W Club, Facility Enhancements, Campaigns, and more.

NOTE: Priority Points come into play when allocating parking, premium seating, away game tickets, and Bowl Game Tickets.

PRIORITY PARKING



- Football and Basketball parking will be allocated separately
- Donors will be able to request lots for each sport based on their preference, availability, and priority points
- Provide more value for those Cowboy Joe Members who have basketball season tickets
- Stadium & Stadium Preferred are first come first serve, subject to overflow parking in Summit View
- Shuttle service provided from Cowboy Field Lot (Brown Lot) to gate 8

Due to ongoing facility projects in the nearby area, some parking lots may be offline over the next 2-3 years. Those members impacted will be offered alternative parking options. For specific questions related to 2023 priority parking, Tailgate Alley, or RV parking please call the CJC Office at 307-766-6242. If no requests are made, your gameday parking will be defaulted based on your giving level.

Open Container lots for 2023 include the AA, Gateway, Pete's Party Lawn, Ford Stadium Lot, FA, H, IPF, X, Summit View, Cowboy Field, and Brown Lot. The open container policy runs up to kickoff. Parking is available as early as 5:00 PM the day before home football games and can be coordinated by contacting the Cowboy Joe Club office at 307-766-6242.

UNIQUE METHODS OF SUPPORT

ENDOWMENTS & CAPITAL GIVING

Other than contributing to the Cowboy Joe Club's annual scholarship fund, gifts may also be made to the endowment program and toward capital (facility) enhancements.

MATCHING GIFTS

If you or your spouse are affiliated with one of the 600 matching gift companies in the U.S., your firm may match the value of your annual gift to the CJC. Donors who take advantage of the matching program may double or triple your membership level/benefits.

UW FACULTY / STAFF MATCH

COMPLIANCE CORNER

IMPORTANT COMPLIANCE INFORMATION FOR COWBOY JOE CLUB MEMBERS

As a member of the Cowboy Joe Club, you are also considered to be a "booster" of UW Athletics. Maintaining the high standards of integrity with which all UW Athletics programs operate is of the utmost importance. Therefore, please ask the Athletics Compliance staff if you have any questions concerning interactions with our student-athletes and/or our sport programs.

WHAT IS AN "EXTRA BENEFIT" AND WHY DO I NEED TO KNOW THIS TERM?

An extra benefit is anything that is provided to a student-athlete, their family or friends by an institutional staff member or a booster that is not available to the general student body or general public under the same terms. Providing UW student-athletes, their families or friends with anything considered an extra benefit jeopardizes their eliqibility to represent UW in competition.

RECENT NCAA VIOLATIONS INVOLVING BOOSTERS

An NCAA Member institution is alleged to have provided the stepfather of a student-athlete with \$800 and 12 nights of lodging valued at \$2,500. Additionally, that same student-athlete allegedly received loaner vehicles and a \$3,000 loan. Had this student-athlete not decided to forgo his last remaining year of eligibility in order to enter the NFL Draft, he very likely would have been ruled permanently ineligible based on the severity of the violations.
